Aughnasheelin Club History

Aughnasheelin GAA Club takes its beginning from 1889, the first-year clubs were set up in Leitrim, and Aughnasheelin was part of the Oughteragh Wolfe Tones team. Throughout the following decades, including turbulent times in the 1930s and the ravages of emigration over the years, Aughnasheelin has remained a strong and thriving club.

While our current club facilities are up there with the best in the county, it has taken many years of hard work to progress from Mick Gilhooly's field at "the shreheen" to where we are today. We are very proud of our club's facilities, which were developed in 1984 for the centenary year and



redeveloped in 2005, Indeed developments continue at our club as we are delighted to have completed our flood lighting, walking track, fully equipped gym and the redecoration of our club rooms in recent times.

Aughnasheelin has a long history of successful underage teams. Many of today's players on our intermediate team were county medal winners at all underage levels and represented Aughnasheelin at all levels for Leitrim. Some of our players today are current members of the Leitrim Senior Panel - Aaron Hore, Ciaran Cullen and Conor Cullen (the latter unfortunately injured for today's game). We are very proud in having had 3 players, Rory McNulty, Michael Horgan and Ryan McWeeney, on the All Ireland winning Ballinamore Area under 10 community games team who took home Gold in September this year, along with our club's representative Shane McNulty who was part of the successful management team.

Aughnasheelin can boast a lot more than football; there are six All Ireland Senior Scór medals in the club; talented ladies who have also won county football titles; the previous county board chairman was an Aughnasheelin man Terence Boyle; Seamus Prior from Aughnasheelin refereed the Senior All Ireland Football Final in 1991; Michael Domican, Brendan Mulvey, Fergal Earley, Joe Earley, Paul Earley and Paddy McManus have all lined out for the Leitrim Senior Hurling team and indeed brothers Paul and Fergal Earley are Lory Meagher medal winners with Paul and Paddy selected as Lory Meagher All Star Hurling Award Winners.

The intermediate championship wins in 2008 and 2017 were momentous occasions and today's final is another one of those golden moments for the club. We are very proud to be here today. The team has worked hard for it and we hope that it is an enjoyable game for all and will be another historic day for Aughnasheelin.

Paul Earley is a 32-year-old Cardiac Physiologist based in Dublin. Paul has grown up with and played football with a lot of the players on this team today. He lines out today with his equally talented brother Joe. Paul is one of the best corner backs in Leitrim, his bravery and tigerish defending is a joy to watch and he is also one of the nicest people you are ever likely to come across. Paul was a key player on the Intermediate Championship winning teams for Aughnasheelin in 2008 and 2017 along with the Division 2 League winning team of 2014. Paul also holds Minor and U21 football Championship medals.

Paul Is not just a wonderful footballer but is also a very talented hurler having represented Leitrim Senior hurling team for many years. He was the proud recipient of a Lory Meagher All Star award in 2015 and was also an integral part of the historic Leitrim hurling team which won the All-Ireland Lory Meagher Cup back in 2019. Paul also holds 3 Leitrim senior championship hurling medals.

In common with most of Leitrim, the GAA came to Annaduff in 1889 with the formation of Annaduff Parnellites and Drumsna Connaught Rangers, but this flowering was to the short lived. While the club came and went during subsequent years, due to emigration and lack of players, some notable successes were achieved, the most significant being the winning of our first Senior Championship in 1928 with a team backboned by Nipper Shanley and Pee Masterson.

From then up to the club's reformation in 1958, Annaduff came and went on the Leitrim GAA scene, enjoying some success at Junior level. When the Club fielded a Junior team in 1958, it would have been hard to imagine that it would begin an era of over 60 plus years of continuous existence. But great things have happened in that time. Our park, named in honour of the late Stanley Cox was officially opened in 1983, which coincided with the long-awaited Junior Championship success. The Park has been consistently upgraded in the intervening years and is now one of the finest club grounds in Leitrim.

On the playing fields, Annaduff has been successful at all levels, winning titles in every grade, the most significant being the Senior Championship in 2004 and our last triumph at Intermediate level in 2001. Our sister club, Annaduff Ladies also captured three Senior titles during this time. Our population is increasing again which is welcome and this has been recognised by the club, which has a very active and successful Coiste na Óg with our Academy serving the younger members of our club from under 5's to 17's.

As a result of our increasing membership and demand on our facilities Annaduff GAA has embarked on an ambitious phased development program. Phase 1 is a 40m x 20m floodlit Astroturf facility; Phase 2 is a bollard lite walkway around our main and training pitches; phase 3 will be a playground and phase 4 will be the full floodlighting of our main playing pitch. 

The Volcano Has Erupted Tommy Moran

Mount Vesuvius is the only active volcano on the European mainland. It has been grumbling away underground since its last eruption in March 1944, something that didn't really catch the news headlines, as it occurred just after the Italians invaded Italy during the Second World War. The previous eruption was in 1631, so it's not a common occurrence.



Much more common, unfortunately, is the abuse that erupts from many a sideline, stand, terrace, dug-out, television screen, radio, club notes, bar-stool, Snapchat, Twitter or Facebook accounts at the man in the middle. Referees have been lambasted for years, but Cumann Luthchleas Gael and its Uachtaran, Larry McCarthy, have seen and heard enough, so their anger and frustration at the situation have erupted and in no way will it be kept away from the news or sports headlines.

This weekend, a time of many county finals, has been designated as Referee Respect Day, October 22nd/23rd, throughout the country, when, it is hoped that the Association to which we all belong – and are delighted to be so – will extend common courtesy to the referees and that counties will celebrate the role of referees and match officials in some form. Of course the good intentions will all come to nothing unless each of us plays our part. The referee will be playing his part and whistling as he sees the situation at the time. He will make several decisions during the game, on the spot decisions, and it is possible that one or two might be wrong --- but they won't all be wrong, it is pure nonsense to think that. If the Pope was reffing he wouldn't be infallible for the hour or so.

Maybe they had the perfect solution in Faughey, Killarque or in Ballyknockan Bottoms in the Aughavas/Cloone area, back in the early days, when they played hurling and football matches, as described by Fr Dan Gallogly in Sceal Liatroma, with no rules, no goalposts, no sidelines, no time-keeping, no strength and conditioning coaches, no programmes and no referee. Hurleys were made from bog oak and might be eight feet long and the caimin was as big as a pot lid, while the football was sown from an ass's hide or the skin of a dog. But that wasn't perfect either, as heads were split, arms were broken and men went home in their gores of blood. A referee might have been a bit of a help.

Every referee wants to be a help, to officiate within the rules, to keep the game flowing, to make the hard calls if necessary, to be fair to both teams, to liaise with his officials, to be up with the play, to be as anonymous on the field as possible, to do everything that he has trained and trained to do correctly.

Today, give the referees a break, bite your tongue, see the full picture rather than just your own team, but enjoy the games and do your bit to make this a special day and hopefully a new beginning for the referees.

The GAA is part of what we are. Referee Respect should be part of it also.
