

### **Aughnasheelin Club History**

Club Name: Achadh Na Sileann

The first mention of football in Aughnassheelin would be at county convention held in Drumshanbo oct 20th 1889, the team was known as Oughteragh Wolf Tones with the most of the team coming from the lower half of the parish taking in Cornawall. The club applied to be affiliated but there was an objection from the Ballinamore club known as William McBriens, the argument was that one team was enough in the parish. the parish is known as Oughteragh with Aughnasheelin the half parish. The Wolf Tones delegate stated categorically that they would never join with Ballinamore. To cut a long story short Wolf tones applied the following year and were successful so the club dates from 1890.

Although the club has only one senior title in the early 1900s they contested the county final of 1933 against Ballinamore it ended in a draw and the replay ended in a narrow win for Ballinamore. The club went out of existence for a few years in the 50s most of the players played with Ballinamore. The club was reformed in the late 50s and was to prove a very successful era with four league titles and a junior championship win in 1965, a senior league title in 1969 beating neighbours Ballinamore in the final.

Fast forward to 1978 the club won its first under age title beating Cloone to win the u12 title, that team would go on to win all underage titles and were narrowly beaten in the minor championship final of '84. The next big win at under 12

would be 1997 when Aughnasheelin beat Anaduff in the final, the present team consists of a few from that side namely Gavin and Barry McWeeney, Wayne Gilgunn, Cathal Egan, Gavin Sammon and Vincent Mulvey. The following year the club would represent Leitrim in Feile in Donegal staying with the Fared Gales club.

All of the present team have won minor and u21 titles with Oughteragh gales. The club have provided many players to county teams down the years in all grades going back to 1927 with the late cannon Joe Dolan to the present time with Barry McWeeney and Niall Murray. We also have a strong tradition of Ladies football in Aughnasheelin, our present team were beaten in the junior Championship final last Weekend. This year we have won the U14 9-aside championship, we are in the 9 aside U12 final against Allen Gaels and our minor side are in the league final. The club grounds were purchased in the early 80s and have been upgraded in recent years with a training area added also this year two new dressing rooms, gym and meeting room have been added on. The club won best grounds in 2006. There is also a very strong tradition of Scór in Aughnasheelin and the club won the all Ireland title in 2006 in the ballad group section. The group were made up of Cait, Declan and Brendan Sammon, Sinead Egan and Sile Mc Nulty. The club have a strong tradition of refereeing in the county and country and our own Seamus Prior refereed all Ireland Finals at minor and senior.

We would like to wish the lads the best of luck in the final.



### **Drumkeerin Club History**

Brian Hoare N.T of Knockcroghery, Co Roscommon a teacher in Allenview National School organised the first Drumkeeerin Gaelic football team in the modern era. Before coming to Drumkeerin he played club football in Dublin and he also wore the Roscommon Senior jersey. Drumkeeran took part in the North Leitrim League when teams played for the "London Cup". The clubs first game, on Sunday 2nd April 1933, was played in Buchannan's Field which lies between the Dowra road and the Old road and resulted in a defeat to a Ballinaglera team. The Club flourished throughout the thirties. Among the Drumkeerin men who played were John Clinton John McKenna, Vincent O'Donnell, Frank Mc Grail, John Walsh, Hubie McParland, Felix McParland, and Charlie Higgins. Among the players who played before the club was formally set up were Michael VBlest, Barney Owens, Chappie O'Donnell, Johnny O'Neill, Godfrey O'Donnell, Miley Gilroy, Hughie Rourke, and Michael William Higgins.

Pat Christy, Larry Christy, Myles Christy, Pete Gilroy, Shane Corristine, Johnny McLoughlin, Hughie Mc Morrow, Tommy Gilhooley, Eddie McPartland, Tommy Guihan, Mike Higgins continued the tradition initiated by Brian Hoare in 1933. Proper football boots were rare and gradually as funds were collected the club was able to acquire boots. Dances and suppers were the principal fundraisers were held on the old Barrack loft, in Crow's hall or in Kelly's Hall. Food for the suppers was provided by the mothers of the players. Each player usually brought a can of fresh milk. Dance and supper combined cost1s – 3p. Funds were also raised by organising a sports day, which could yield up to £20. A match was usually played in conjunction with the sports and a dance finished off the days activities. Incidentally the first jersey worn by the 30's players were blue and yellow.

Jack Walsh NT, Seamus Duignan, Patrick Forde, Tom Beirne, Paddy Kelly, Sonny Crown and Jim Gallagher facilitated the transition of Drumkeerin football from the early years into the fifties and sixties. Fr. Seamus Duffy a Meath native was appointed curate in Inishmagrath in 1953. Fr. Duffy was instrumental in acquiring a field on the Manorhamilton road, where all games, up to the purchase of the present pitch, were played. It was here that senior players like the O'Connor brothers,, Seamus Fallon, Joe Leyden, Tommy Gilhooley, Paddy Forde, Anthony O'Rourke, Jack McGee, James Doherty, Liam Bouchier, Paddy Joe McGovern, Tom Fallon, John James Fallon, John McLoughlin, Michael McHugh, Jim Hazlette, Gerry Rourke, Michael McNulty, Paddy McGowan. Mickey Davitt, Charlie Flynn, Gerry Rynn, TommyCassidy, Martin Devitt and Joe Davitt showed their skill. The Fr. Duffy era was significant for the advance in Drumkeerin's football fortunes but also was a time of appalling emigration when whole families sold out and left the country. Most promising players in the area were lost. Before Fr. Duffy left in 1961, efforts were made to hold

the club together and the formation of a minor team which at a stage amalgamated with Drumshanbo. This minor team bridged the gap between the fifties and the era of the early sixties. The club was revived in 1963 on the arrival of a Cavan man, Eamonn O'Grady who was the driving force of the club for many years. In 1964 Drumkeerin lost to Annaduff in the Junior Championship Final, however in 1966 the junior title was claimed by defeating Mohill. The Junior League was won in 1967 when Fenagh did not play the final, and in 1969 the club reached the semi-finals of the County Senior Championship, losing out to Melvin Gaels.

Curiously enough the club lapsed in 1973 despite having won Minor League titles in 1970 &'71, and the Junior League in '71. The club was reorganised in October 1973 with Chairman Charlie Flynn, Secretary Andy Redican, and Treasurer Tony Forde. Drumkeerin were defeated by Aughawillan in the 1974 Junior Championship Final but in 1975 made amends winning the League and Championship double defeating Eslin. In 1975, Shamrock Gaels amalgamation of Dromahair, Drumkeerin and Drumshanbo won the County Minor Championship Title. 1981 brought further success winning the Junior League. In 1983 the club completed the purchase of a new club ground which was negotiated by Clare native Michael Hanley R.I.P. who was club Chairman. Drumkeerin enjoyed a very successful 1980's at underage level and in October 1986 Drumkeerin and Dromahair played an U14 Challenge game in Croke Park. In 1988 Andy Redican won the Leitrim clubman of the year award.

The 1990's saw continued success at underage level. Pairc Naomh Brid was officially opened in May 1993 with Derry and Leitrim playing a Senior Challenge. In 2000 the Intermediate team lost to St Mary's in the final. The club reached the Senior B Championship final in 2004 losing out to Glencar/Manor. In 2005 our second team captured the Division 3 League. In 2006 the U21's won the 13 aside Championship. In 2007 Division 3 league was captured and the U21's reached the final of the 15aside. The 2000's have proved another successful decade at underage level and also for the club ladies and girls football achieving County and Connacht success. The player profile section of this programme illustrates the underage success achieved with this current Panel of players. The club facilities are constantly improving with a pitch upgrade and a new training pitch, also plans are in place for extension to the clubrooms. The Handball Club has been reformed and is flourishing with the construction of a new Court & Gym facility at Pairc Naomh Brid. From this brief history we have a Proud Parish and Club tradition with Gaels past and present.


